## **Forklift Safety Training Phoenix**

Forklift Safety Training Phoenix - Those wanting work in companies that utilize lift trucks must undergo a forklift safety training program prior to becoming a certified operator of a forklift. There are many ways to go about acquiring forklift safety training. Courses are provided through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved video and online courses. The cost can be minimal (or free) when offered through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

In most countries, lift truck operators are required to be over the age of 18 years old. Local industry bodies in cooperation with local and federal authorities can approve the forklift safety training courses. They require that operators obtain forklift certification before utilizing a forklift machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Companies that hire workers to drive forklift trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators could lead to serious injuries and property damage due to improper utilization of the equipment. Training consists of the correct loading and driving methods. Workers need to pass a written test in order to be certified. A company would normally designate a supervisor to provide hands-on training to new workers. A licensed supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be certified as a trainer.

Individuals seeking work as forklift operators have options for obtaining forklift safety training and certification. Forklift training could be available through a workforce development agency or an employment agency. Those seeking work as forklift operators can enroll in forklift safety training programs provided by an approved trainer at an independent site. Manual laborers could find more job opportunities if they have lift truck certification.

A different alternative for prospective trainees is to look forklift safety training via the World Wide Web. The training will be provided to the trainee via video streams and other online formats. However, certification usually requires that students write an exam and take a lift truck driving test.
